- Can you please read me a story?

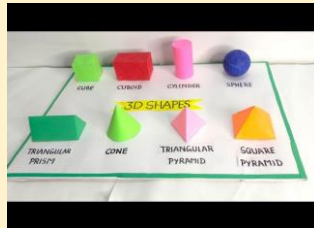

- संज्ञा, सर्वनाम और कारक में से उदाहरण सहित किसी एक के भेद संबंधित चार्ट बनाइए।



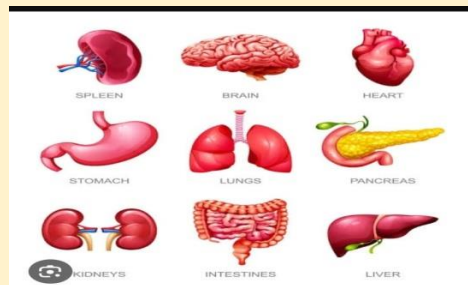
MATHS
